



AUTHORITIES

- ORS 399.065 Ordering organized militia into active state service; martial law.
 - 1. The Governor may order organized militia into state active service in case of invasion, disaster, insurrection, riot, breach of the peace, or threat thereof.
- ORS 399.075 Ordering organized militia to state active duty; pay and allowances.
 - 1. The Adjutant General may order organized militia to state active duty with the Governor's approval.
 - 2. Service Members called to state active duty are considered temporary employees of the military department.
 - 3. Service Members called to state active duty are to receive no less than the U.S. Armed Forces pay and allowances for their corresponding grades.
