

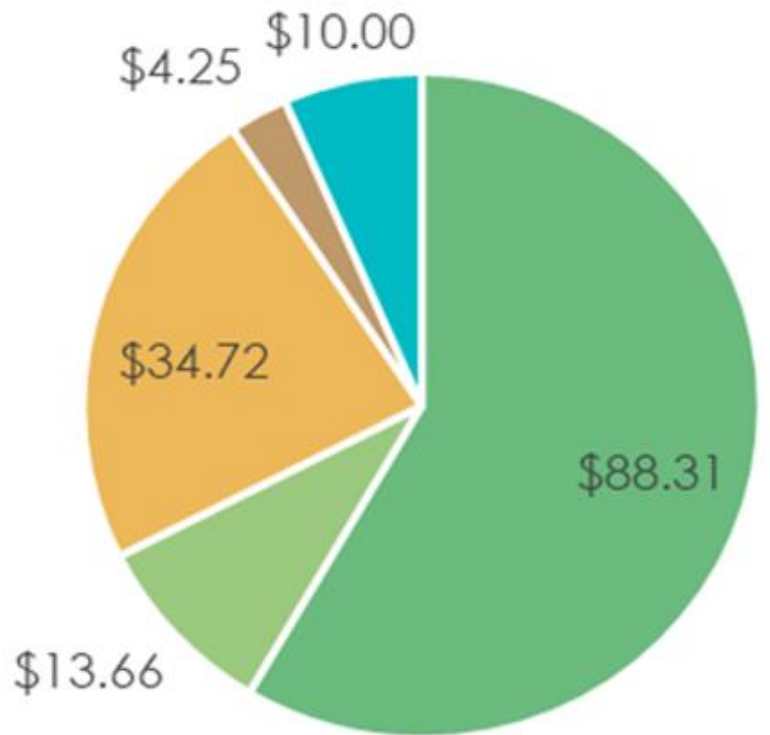

2021 State Funds Expenditure

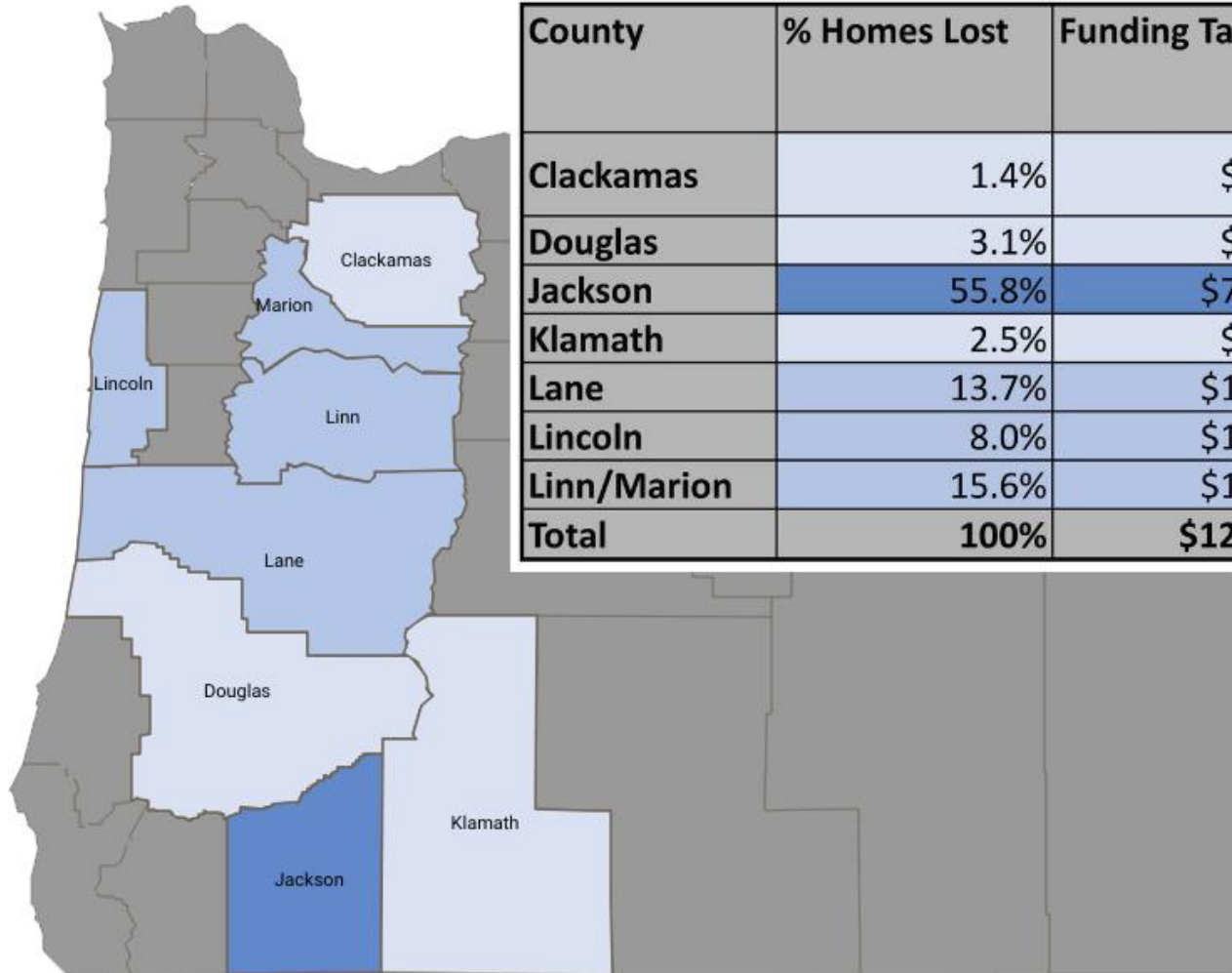
