SUMMARY

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study availability of community-based services for individuals who are on conditional release from civil commitment. Directs authority to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary not later than September 15, 2024. Sunsets January 2, 2025.

- 2 Relating to civil commitment.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall study the availability of community-based services for individuals who are on conditional release from civil commitment. The authority shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation to improve access to community-based services for individuals on conditional release, to the interim com-
- mittees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary no later than September 15, 2024.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
