

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

Item 6: Teacher Standards and Practices Commission Equity Centered Principals Pipeline

The Education Subcommittee recommends that the Emergency Board increase Other Funds expenditure limitation by \$269,072 and authorize the establishment of one limited duration position (0.25 FTE) to develop standards-based leadership practices and develop a statewide framework for school principal preparation.

The Teacher Standards and Practices Commission is one of five Oregon partners participating in the Wallace Foundation's Equity Centered Pipeline Initiative, a program to help school districts build developmental pipelines to produce school leaders. Portland Public Schools serves as the fiscal agent for the \$8.2 million, five-year grant. TSPC, along with Portland State University, Lewis & Clark College, and the Educator Advancement Council in the Department of Education, is a sub-grantee. TSPC's role in the project is to develop a statewide framework for principal training and to develop and implement alternative pathways to principal licensure. The grant funds will pay for the cost of one limited-duration position and the research, travel, program oversight, and other expenses associated with program development.

The Subcommittee recommends approval.
