

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

Item 42: Department of Land Conservation and Development Cape Foulweather Land Acquisition

To: Emergency Board Full Committee

The Education Subcommittee recommends that the Emergency Board approve, retroactively, the submission of a federal grant application by the Department of Land Conservation and Development, to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, in the amount of \$2,011,530 for acquisition of property on the Central Coast of Oregon on Cape Foulweather.

Grant funding is provided through the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration Coastal Zone Management Habitat Protection and Restoration Competition under the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act. Funding will be sub awarded through DLCD to the Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians to acquire 27.32 acres of property on Cape Foulweather, in Lincoln County. DLCD will coordinate due diligence work and will monitor that the property continues to be held in a conservation status. There is no state match required.

The Subcommittee recommends approval.
