Why is the SAT still important?

For millions of students, test scores can strengthen their college applications.

- In the class of 2022, nearly 1.3 million U.S. students had SAT scores that confirmed or exceeded their high school GPA.
- Among those students, more than 400,000 were African American or Latino, nearly 350,000 were first-generation college goers, and nearly 250,000 were from small towns or rural communities.

More than 80% of students and parents want to be able to share SAT scores

The SAT is transitioning to digital

- The SAT Suite will measure the same core college readiness knowledge and skills.
- SAT scores will mean the same thing, on the same scale.
- Tests will be proctored in a school or test center.

Key Benefits for Students

- Students live digital lives and we're meeting them where they are.
- The SAT Suite will be shorter about two hours instead of three, with shorter passages.
- Students and educators will receive scores faster – in days, not weeks.
- The digital SAT Suite will be more secure and flexible to deliver. Each student will get a unique version of the test.



Educators who participated in the pilot told us the digital SAT was easier to give.






