- HB 2430 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
(3:40 pm) CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-25-2021 AGENDA: Extends privilege taxes on merchantable forest products harvested on forestlands.
- HB 2389 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
(3:40 pm) CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-25-2021 AGENDA: Makes taxes levied upon taxpayers for privilege of harvesting merchantable forest products harvested on forestlands permanent.
- HB 2379 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
(4:00 pm) CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-25-2021 AGENDA: Imposes severance tax on owner of timber at time of harvest at five percent of value of timber.
- HB 2357 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
(5:15 pm) Eliminates Oregon Forest Resources Institute and Oregon Forest Resources Institute Fund.
