HB 3379

(1:00 PM) CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-05-2021 MEETING: Prohibits manufacturing, retrofitting, selling, leasing, subletting or otherwise placing into stream of commerce any crib bumper pads or crib equipped with crib bumper pads.

HB 3073 **

HB 2503 **

HB 3109

(1:25 PM) Limits certain restrictions by local governments, planned communities and condominiums on use of property for child care facilities.
