SB 486 A

Modifies requirements of plans of instruction for talented and gifted children.

#### Informational Meeting

*Invited testimony only*

SB 487 A

Directs Department of Education to conduct study on instruction provided to talented and gifted children and to report results of study to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to education.

SB 478 A

Directs school districts to use inclusive and effective methods for identifying talented and gifted children and communicating with parents about process for identifying talented and gifted children.
