HB 3371 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-06-2021 MEETING: (4:00 pm) Requires Department of State Lands to consider potential risks in entering into agreements for authorized use of submerged and submersible lands and allows department to require risk mitigation or insurance.

HB 2263

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-06-2021 MEETING: (4:10 pm) Directs Oregon Liquor Control Commission to study recreational marijuana tracking.

HB 3078

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-06-2021 MEETING: (4:20 pm) Prohibits Oregon State Lottery from offering games playable via mobile phone, personal computer or other personal electronic device, except for certain sports betting and multistate numbers drawing lottery games.

HB 3000

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-06-2021 MEETING: (4:30 pm) Directs Oregon Liquor Control Commission to study cannabis.

HB 3369 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-06-2021 MEETING: (4:40 pm) Requires transfer of moneys from Oregon Marijuana Account to Oregon Health Authority for purposes of administering Oregon Medical Marijuana Program.
