#### **Work Session**

HB 2292 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Department of Human Services to contract with nonprofit organization to implement and administer program to assist recipients of supplemental nutrition assistance in purchasing locally grown fruits and vegetables from farmers' markets, farm share sites and retail outlets that participate in program.

HB 3026

Directs Department of Transportation to waive fee for issuing, renewing or replacing identification card if person who is issued card is experiencing homelessness.

HB 3039

Requires Oregon Health Authority, in coordination with Department of Human Services, to convene one or more groups of stakeholders and experts to study and make recommendations regarding electronic referral system for social services and statewide health information exchange.

# AGENDA (cont.) March 24, 2021

HB 2119

Transfers responsibility for 2-1-1 system from Office of Emergency Management to Department of Human Services.

HB 2544 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Authorizes Department of Human Services to award two-year grants to organizations that provide services to unaccompanied homeless youth and to organizations that operate host home projects for unaccompanied homeless youth.

HB 2348

Requires hospitals and long term care facilities to make available to patients, residents, staff and visitors plant-based meals and beverages.
