HB 2544 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Authorizes Department of Human Services to award two-year grants to organizations that provide services to unaccompanied homeless youth and to organizations that operate host home projects for unaccompanied homeless youth.
HB 2424 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

2424 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs Department of Human Services, in consultation with Oregon Youth Authority and Oregon Health Authority, to develop child-caring agency grant and training program.
