HB 3041

(3:15 pm) Removes "gender identity" from definition of "sexual orientation" in ORS 174.100 and creates standalone definition of "gender identity" in ORS 174.100.

HB 2571

(4:15 pm) Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services, in consultation with State Forestry Department, Oregon State University and Oregon Prescribed Fire Council, to study liability for prescribed fires.
