HB 2205

(3:15 pm) Establishes procedure for person to bring action in name of state to recover civil penalties for violations of state law.

HB 2638

(4:00 pm) Limits liability for certain claims for damages arising out of acts or omissions taken during COVID-19 emergency period in reasonable compliance with government guidance related to COVID-19.

Work Session

HB 3041

Removes "gender identity" from definition of "sexual orientation" in ORS 174.100 and creates standalone definition of "gender identity" in ORS 174.100.

HB 2176

Eliminates minimum amount of fee added to judgment that includes monetary obligation that court or judicial branch is charged with collecting.

HB 2178
