HB 2575

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/15/2021 MEETING: Directs Department of Justice to establish program for awarding grants to law enforcement agencies and local governments for training of groups and agencies that interact with persons who have experienced trauma.

HB 2928

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/15/2021 MEETING: Regulates use of chemical incapacitants, kinetic impact projectiles and sound devices by law enforcement agencies.

Please note: HB 2930 is scheduled solely for the purpose of committee discussion of the measure. HB 2930

Imposes limitations on arbitrators' decisions concerning alleged misconduct by law enforcement officers.

HB 2936

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/15/2021 MEETING: Requires Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to investigate person's character before accepting person for training and certification as police officer or reserve officer.

HB 3047

Establishes civil cause of action for improper disclosure of personal information.

HB 3059

Repeals statute authorizing law enforcement officers to command dispersal of unlawful assemblies and arrest participants who do not disperse.

HB 3145

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/15/2021 MEETING: Directs Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to establish publicly available database of certain information about misconduct and discipline of public safety employees established by department.

HB 3273

Prohibits law enforcement agency from releasing booking photo except in specified circumstances.

HB 3355

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/15/2021 MEETING: Specifies identification required on uniforms of law enforcement officers working in crowd management.
