Public Hearing

HB 2462

Requires pharmacy benefit manager to amend contract with pharmacy or pharmacy services administrative organization or take other steps to adjust reimbursement paid to pharmacy or pharmacy services administrative organization to take into account costs incurred from new taxes or fees.

Work Session

HB 3143

(For discussion purposes only) Provides for daily rather than monthly computation of interest on delinquent property taxes.

HB 2972

(For discussion purposes only) Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to study land value taxation and submit report to interim legislative committees related to revenue.
