Public Hearing

HB 3275 A

Exempts land owned by eligible covenant holder that is burdened by affordable housing covenant requiring permanent affordability from ad valorem property taxation if improvements on land constitute owner-occupied housing.

Work Session

HB 2096 A

Increases maximum agriculture workforce housing tax credits issued by Housing and Community Services Department to \$24 million per biennium.

HB 2584 A

Increases total amount of tax credits for affordable housing lenders allowed for all taxpayers per fiscal year.

HB 2737

Creates subtraction from federal taxable income for amounts received as AmeriCorps national service educational awards, for personal income taxpayers.

HB 3244

Increases maximum amount of tax credits for certified film production development contributions that may be certified for fiscal year for all taxpayers.

HB 3364

Creates credit against income taxes for purchasing publicly supported housing to retain as affordable housing.
