HB 2440

(For discussion purposes only)Extends sunset for tax credit for working family dependent care.

HB 2721

(For discussion purposes only)Allows dependent care income tax credit to be claimed for expenses to allow taxpayer or spouse to attend school as enrolled degree-seeking student.

HB 2441

(For discussion purposes only)Extends sunset for tax credit for university venture development fund contributions.

HB 2442

(For discussion purposes only)Extends sunset for additional personal exemption credit for taxpayer with severe disability.

HB 2444

(For discussion purposes only)Extends sunset for tax credit for child with disability.

HB 2445

(For discussion purposes only)Enacts express sunset for exemption of medical marijuana registry cardholder or primary caregiver from tax imposed on retail sale of marijuana items.

HB 2452

(For discussion purposes only)Extends sunset for tax credit for provision of medical care to residents of Oregon Veterans' Home.

AGENDA (cont.)

May 12, 2021

HB 2781

Authorizes county court to order tax collector to cancel property taxes assessed on certain public real and personal property upon request of tax collector and district attorney who determine such taxes to be wholly uncollectible.

HB 2330 A

Makes permanent school district funding for foreign exchange students and small school district grants.
