#### Work Session

- HB 3167 A  
Repeals sunset of predator damage control district program.
- HB 2440  
Extends sunset for tax credit for working family dependent care.
- HB 2721  
Allows dependent care income tax credit to be claimed for expenses to allow taxpayer or spouse to attend school as enrolled degree-seeking student.
- HB 2441  
Extends sunset for tax credit for university venture development fund contributions.
- HB 2442  
Extends sunset for additional personal exemption credit for taxpayer with severe disability.
- HB 2444  
Extends sunset for tax credit for child with disability.
- HB 2445  
Enacts express sunset for exemption of medical marijuana registry cardholder or primary caregiver from tax imposed on retail sale of marijuana items.
- HB 2452  
Extends sunset for tax credit for provision of medical care to residents of Oregon Veterans' Home.

HB 2021 A

Requires retail electricity providers to reduce greenhouse gas emissions associated with electricity sold to Oregon consumers to 80 percent below baseline emissions levels by 2030, 90 percent below baseline emissions levels by 2035 and 100 percent below baseline emissions levels by 2040.
