HB 2819

Allows otherwise qualified individual to claim earned income tax credit under individual taxpayer identification number in lieu of Social Security number.

HB 3295

Modifies city and county eligibility requirements for transfer of moneys from marijuana revenue.

HB 3373 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes office of Taxpayer Advocate in Department of Revenue.

HB 2357 A

Establishes Sound Forestry Practices Subaccount and Family Forestlands Subaccount as subaccounts of State Forestry Department Account.

HB 3160 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Oregon Wildfire Preparedness and Community Protection Fund and directs State Fire Marshal, State Forestry Department and Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board to make expenditures from fund for various activities related to restoration, protection and recovery from wildfires.

HB 2630

(For discussion purposes only) Provides that, for five school years, calculations of weighted average daily membership made for purposes of distributions of state moneys to school districts may not be decreased for school districts impacted by wildfires in 2020.
