HB 2166

Directs Superintendent of Public Instruction to convene advisory group to review equity in education system of state and to report results of review to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to education.

HB 3112 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Cannabis Equity Board within office of Governor to provide equity oversight of cannabis industry in this state.

SB 60

Extends period for Oregon Government Ethics Commission to complete Preliminary Review Phase of alleged violation of ethics laws from 30 calendar days to 60 calendar days.

SB 61

Authorizes Oregon Government Ethics Commission to provide written commission advisory opinions, staff advisory opinions and oral or written staff advice on application of executive session provisions of Oregon public meetings law.
