HB 2893 **

(3:55 pm) Establishes Oregon Disaster Response Assistance Matching Fund.

HB 2461 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

(4:05 pm) Directs Oregon Business Development Department to establish program to create Oregon Critical Disaster Preparedness Stockpile to ensure robust stock of emergency supplies and equipment.

HB 2891

(4:05 pm) Requires health care facilities, health care providers, local public health authorities and public and private safety agencies to maintain capacity, including sufficient amounts of certain supplies, to continue in normal operation for 120 days at 25 percent mortality rate.

HB 2894 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

(4:25 pm) Directs Office of Emergency Management to create and maintain database for flagging of known or suspected hazardous locations during emergency.

HB 2883 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

(4:35 pm) Establishes Oregon Public Places Are Safe Places Investment Fund.

HB 2593 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

(4:45 pm) Permits Office of Emergency Management to enter into agreement with nonprofit organization representing sheriffs under which organization is authorized to administer program to produce and sell outdoor recreation search and rescue cards.

Written Testimony

Testimony must be received within 24 hours after the start time of the meeting in which the public hearing is held.
