#### Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2244

(8:00 am) Provides that filing of petition appealing final order in other than contested case issued by Water Resources Commission or Water Resources Department in either circuit court or Court of Appeals may not stay enforcement of order of commission or department that regulated off use of water in favor of determined claim, in-stream water right held by state agency or water right held by, or held in trust for, federally recognized Indian tribe.

(8:30 am) Limits time for Water Resources Commission to enforce standards related to wells against well constructor.

HB 2470

(9:00 am) Requires Water Resources Commission to conduct technical review of each well log submitted to commission.
