(8:15 am) CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-30-2021 MEETING: Establishes Oregon Renewable Options Program.
- HB 2344
(8:30 am) Requires persons that have responsibility for or control over packaging and labeling disposable cleaning cloths or similar implements with specified characteristics to comply with certain labeling requirements for product packaging.
