HB 3125 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

(8:00 am) Directs Department of Transportation to create emergency contact information form and make form available for individuals to voluntarily provide emergency contact information for inclusion in individual's motor vehicle record for police officers to use, during or after emergency situations, to contact those listed.

HB 3339

(8:10 am) Prohibits willfully obstructing, blockading, interfering with or preventing use of railroad-highway grade crossing for longer than 10 consecutive minutes.
