#### **Possible Work Session**

SB 236

Directs Early Learning Division to conduct study on use of suspension and expulsion in early childhood care and education programs and to report results of study to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to education.

SB 226

Directs Department of Education to conduct study on education system of state and to report results of study to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to education.

#### **Work Session**

SB 602

Removes sunset on requirement that students must receive certain information related to statewide summative assessments.

SB 356

Creates position of School Nurse Specialist in Department of Education.

SB 594

Prohibits school district boards from authorizing, and school districts from using, certain monitoring software related to students' computer usage.

## AGENDA (cont.) April 12, 2021

SB 225

Directs Department of Education to conduct study on education system of state and to report results of study to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to education.

SB 623

Requires local workforce development boards to evaluate programs administered by state workforce agencies through WorkSource Oregon system.

SB 732

Requires school districts to establish educational equity advisory committee.

SB 233

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish common course numbering system for all introductory and lower level courses offered at public post-secondary institutions of education.

SB 334

Requires directors of school districts and education service districts, superintendents of schools districts and education service districts, members of public charter school governing bodies and principals of public charter schools to receive specified training.

SB 232

Directs Department of Education, in collaboration with Teacher Standards and Practices Commission, to conduct study to identify most effective methods to diversify educator workforce and to report results of study to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to education.

SB 804

Requires school district boards to ensure that specified percentage of expenditures of school district are paid as compensation to teachers of core academic subjects or manual skills.

Note change: SB 623, SB 732, SB 233, SB 334, SB 232, and SB 804, all from the 4/7/2021 agenda, have been added.
