HB 2135

Prohibits Teacher Standards and Practices Commission from issuing license or registration to person convicted of crime constituting domestic violence.

HB 2537 A

Allows school districts to use moneys distributed from Student Investment Account for payment of student fees, costs and instructors of career and technical student organization programs.

HB 2631 A

Prescribes notification requirements for school district upon receipt of report of act of harassment, intimidation, bullying or cyberbullying.

HB 2954

Allows public charter school to implement weighted lottery that favors historically underserved students when number of applications for enrollment exceeds capacity of program, class, grade level or building.

HB 2969 A

Directs school districts to provide age-appropriate instruction in oral health as part of health education curriculum.

HB 3234 A

Requires school districts to provide instruction on organ and tissue donation and education.
