Work Session

HB 2537 A

Allows school districts to use moneys distributed from Student Investment Account for payment of student fees, costs and instructors of career and technical student organization programs.

HB 2631 A

Prescribes notification requirements for school district upon receipt of report of act of harassment, intimidation, bullying or cyberbullying.

HB 2969 A

Directs school districts to provide age-appropriate instruction in oral health as part of health education curriculum.

HB 3183 A

Requires parents of child who is deaf or deafblind or who is hard of hearing to be provided information about relevant services and placements offered by school district, education service district, regional programs and Oregon School for the Deaf whenever individualized family service plan or individualized education program is developed, revised or reviewed.
