Increases maximum percentage of tax that governing body of city or county may impose on sale of marijuana items.

## Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2434 A

Removes sunset of increase in aircraft fuel taxes made by House Bill 2075 (chapter 700, Oregon Laws 2015).

HB 2438 A

Authorizes county with population of less than 15,000 to adopt property tax exemption for newly constructed single-family dwellings built and occupied as primary residences by individuals with annual taxable income of not more than \$75,000 if filing separately or not more than \$150,000 if filing jointly.

HB 2456 A

Makes corrections to and updates tax statutes.

HB 2634 A

Allows surviving spouse or disabled heir of individual whose homestead was granted deferral under homestead property tax deferral program to continue deferral without having owned or occupied homestead for five years.
