HB 2508 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04/26/2021 AGENDA: Prescribes requirements for reimbursement by Oregon Health Authority and coordinated care organizations of health services delivered using telemedicine.

HB 2508 is scheduled solely for the purpose of hearing testimony from those who were unable to speak at the 4/26/2021 meeting.

HB 2965

Extends deadline for local plans for applying foundational capabilities and implementing foundational programs related to public health to December 31, 2025.

HB 3369 A

Allows nurse to discuss medical use of marijuana with patient.

HB 2077

Requires person to identify to Oregon Health Authority third party that performs lead-based paint activities or renovation.

HB 2078 A

Repeals electronic credentialing information program.

HB 2081 A

HB 2627

Allows expanded practice dental hygienist to perform interim therapeutic restoration.

HB 3057
