SB 496

CARRIED OVER FROM 3/16/2021 AGENDA: Removes prohibition on payment of unemployment insurance benefits to nonprofessional employees of educational institution providing school food services or services as employee of federal Head Start program for weeks of unemployment commencing during period between two successive academic years or terms.

SB315

> Exempts from required disclosure business, commercial, financial, operational and research data and information that is furnished, developed or generated in connection with ownership or operation of unmanned aerial system test range, if disclosure of information would cause competitive disadvantage to test range or users.

SB 111

Modifies provisions relating to public employee retirement.

Provides that common law employees are employees for purposes of Public Employees Retirement System.
