#### **Work Session**

SB 420

Permits local contract review board or local contracting agency to enact or adopt, as appropriate, ordinance, resolution, rule, regulation or other legislative or administrative measure to designate certain public improvement contracts as community benefit contracts.

SB 716

Requires employers to reasonably accommodate employee's work schedule availability related to child care.
