- SB 32 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Changes amounts or amount caps for various fees related to livestock branding and feedlot licensing.
- SB 33 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Authorizes State Department of Agriculture to establish additional food safety program license fees for fiscal years beginning July 1, 2022, and July 1, 2023.
- SB 59 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Eliminates sunset on Columbia River Fisheries Enhancement Fund.
- SB 126
Allows Department of State Lands to expand estuarine research reserve management area to include other lands acquired by department connected to Coos Bay estuary.
