SB342

> Directs State Department of Agriculture to study and make recommendations for pesticide regulation and provide results of study in report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2022.

SB762

> Directs Legislative Policy and Research Office to study strategies to promote wildfire response and recovery and report to appropriate committee or interim committee of Legislative Assembly on or before September 15, 2022.

SB337

> Requires State Forestry Department to study and make recommendations to interim committee of Legislative Assembly regarding efficacy of forest policy.

SB 344

Requires State Forestry Department to study and make recommendations to interim committee of Legislative Assembly regarding efficacy of prescribed burns.
