HB 2094

Authorizes Housing and Community Services Department to define "veteran" by rule for Oregon Housing Fund programs.

HB 2231

Exempts certain types of voluntary service in uniformed service from five-year limit on eligibility for reemployment rights in private and public sectors.

HB 2700

Modifies criteria for erecting roadside memorial signs for deceased veterans formerly prisoners of war or unaccounted for.
