Key Rule Provisions for THW Certification

Grandfathering

- 3,000 hours of experience in last 10 years
- (2,000 for PSS)

Certification:

- Successful completion of training + background check
- Increased training hours for PSS certification

Registry

- Inclusion of rules relating to PSS
- Increased training hours for PSS certification

Background Checks

- Required by Law
- Weighing test to determine eligibility for certification
- Smaller exclusion list of crimes for PSS

Continuing Education

- 20 hours every 3 years
- Plus 1.5 to 3 hours of Oral Health

Birth Doulas

- Any training program that meets the standards

Peer Support Specialist Certification Requirements

(1) To be certified as a peer support specialist, an individual shall:

- (a) Complete all required training offered by an Authority approved training program for peer support specialists;
- (b) Complete an Authority approved oral health training.
- (c) Complete all application requirements to be in the state registry;
- (d) Complete the Authority certification process; and
- (e) Be successfully accepted into the state registry

Six Major crimes that disqualify Someone from THW Certification with the state

If an individual has been convicted of any of the crimes listed below (or attempt, conspiracy, or solicitation for any of the crimes) regardless of how long ago the conviction occurred, **THE INDIVIDUAL IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE POSITION**

- ORS 163.095, Aggravated murder
- ORS 163.115, Murder
- ORS 163.375, Rape I
- ORS 163.405, Sodomy I
- ORS 163.411, Unlawful sexual penetration I
- ORS 163.427, Sexual abuse I
