
DPSST Mission

Criminal Justice Moral Fitness Standards:

Mandatory:

- Criminal Convictions
 - Felonies
 - Crimes involving elements of drugs, domestic violence, child abuse or sexual abuse
- Discharges for cause
 - Addition of Discriminatory Behavior

Discretionary:

- All other findings of guilt to any criminal offense
- All other non-voluntary separations from employment
- Falsification
- Academy Dismissal
- Complaints

2020 HB 4207

Section 3 Required the DPSST to:

- Establish a publically-accessibly online database of suspensions and revocations of police certifications.
- Include in the database:
 - The officer's name
 - The officer's employer
 - A description of the facts underlying the suspension/revocation
- Update the database within 10 days following the exhaustion of appeal rights
- Submit to the legislature an annual report summarizing and analyzing the data in the database

Criminal Justice Professional Standards Database:

August 8, 2020 – Database published:


- Included the name, DPSST number, discipline and employer of:
 - A public safety officer/dispatcher whose certification was revoked or denied on or after 6/30/20
 - A link to the Final Order Revoking or Denying Certification
- Also published:
 - All revocations, denials and suspensions occurring prior to 6/30/20
 - All open, pending professional standards cases

Criminal Justice Professional Standards Database:

January 22, 2021 – Databases combined/expanded:

- All open and recently closed cases
- Reason for case open
- Details of case closure
- Link to all DPSST-created reports:
 - Administrative Closure Reports
 - Policy Committee Staff Reports
 - Board Staff Reports
 - Notices of Intent/Final Orders
 - Stipulated Final Orders
