

**HB 2742 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY**

**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Allows holder of off-premises sales license to sell malt beverages, wine, and cider in factory-sealed containers that hold more than seven gallons. Authorizes the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to adopt rules. Becomes operative January 1, 2022. Takes effect 91 days following adjournment sine die.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

An off-premises sales license may sell factory-sealed containers of malt beverages, wine, and cider at retail to individuals in Oregon for consumption off the licensed premises and sell malt beverages, wine, and cider to individuals in a securely covered container ("growler") for consumption off the licensed premises. House Bill 2764 allows holders of off-premises sales licenses to sell factory-sealed containers of malt beverages, beer, and wine that hold more than seven gallons. Directs the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to adopt rules.
