### **Measure Description:**

Directs Department of Education to develop and implement statewide education plan for students who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, two-spirit, intersex, asexual, nonbinary or another minority gender identity or gender orientation.

**Analysis:** This measure directs Department of Education (ODE) to develop and implement statewide education plan for students who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer/questioning, 2-spirit, intersex, asexual, non-binary, or another minority gender identity or gender orientation (LGBTQ2SIA+).

ODE does not currently have a statewide student plan focused on the daily lived experiences of LGBTQ2SIA+ students. In 2019, ODE created a LGBTQ2SIA+ Advisory group to develop a student plan to engage LGBTQ2SIA+ students in developing the plan. The plan was developed to conform to the Student Success Act priorities.

ODE, as part of the Governor's budget, has requested \$2 million in Grant-in-Aid funding to implement the LGBTQ2SIA+ Student Success Plan for grants to organizations. In addition, to provide management and oversight for the Plan, ODE has requested one permanent Operations and Policy Analyst position and funds for the administration of the plan.

School Districts do not anticipate a fiscal impact, but that depends upon the requirements set out in the final LGBTQ2SIA+ Success Plan.

This measure requires budgetary action for the appropriation of the funding for the grants as well as resources and position establishment.
