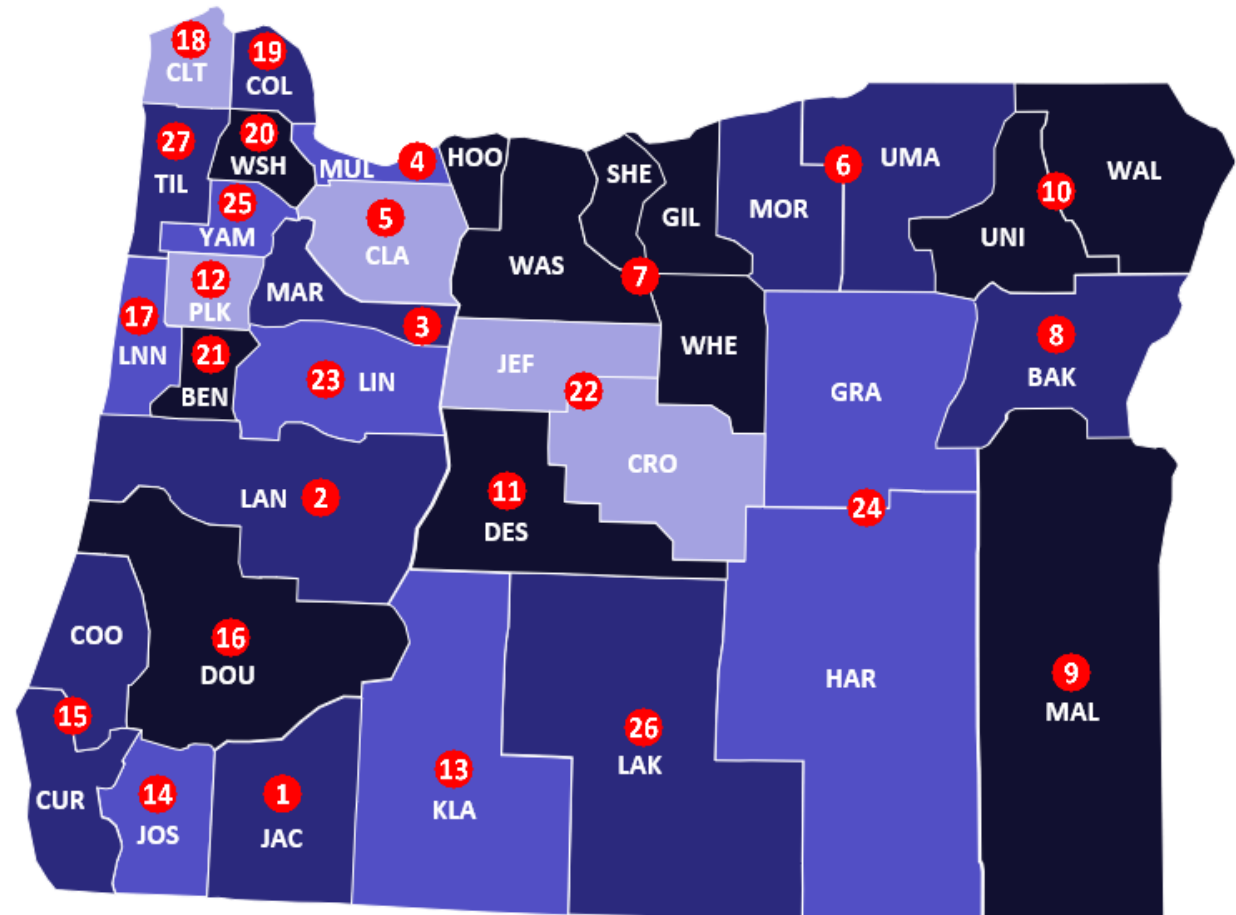

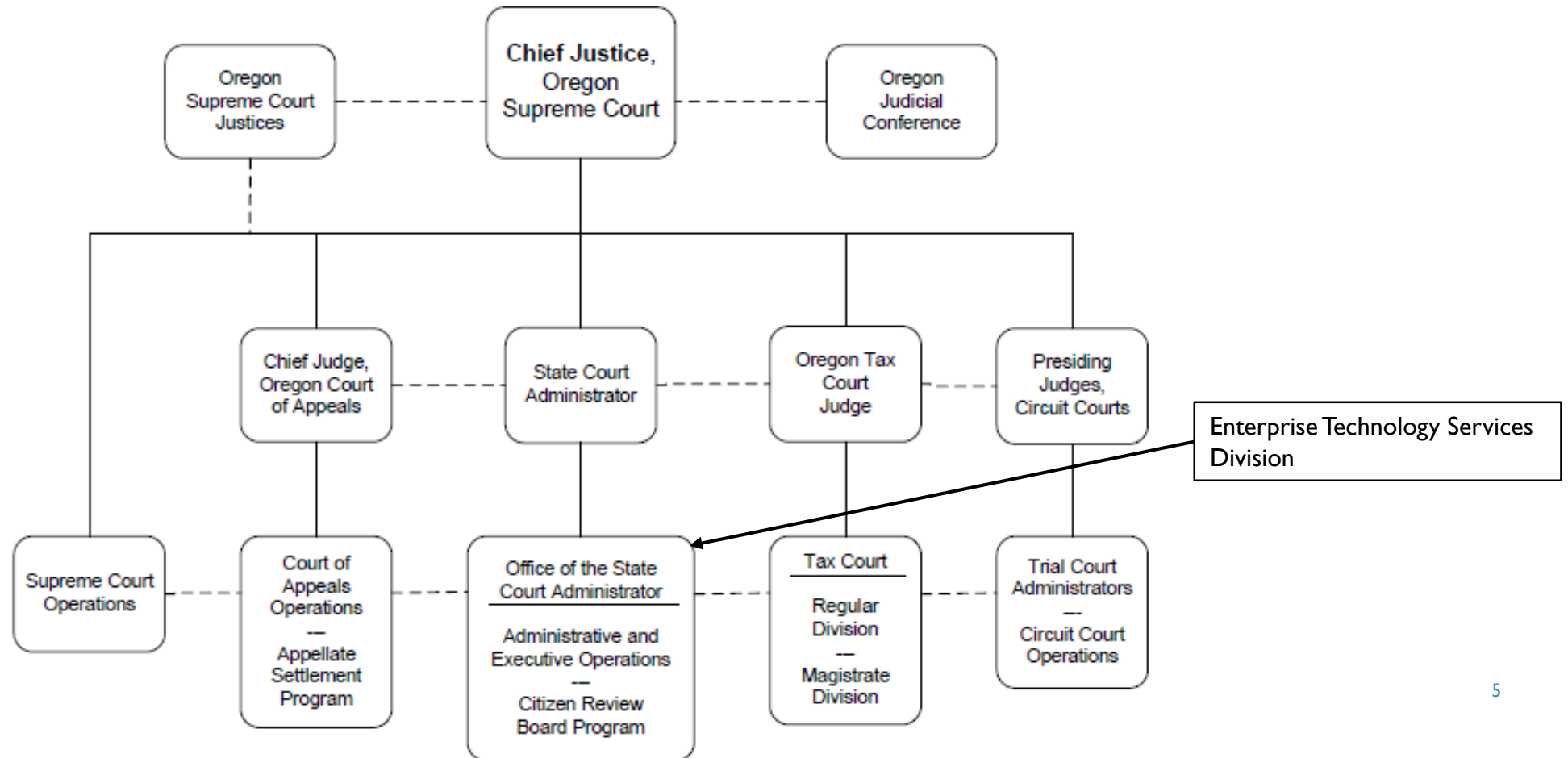

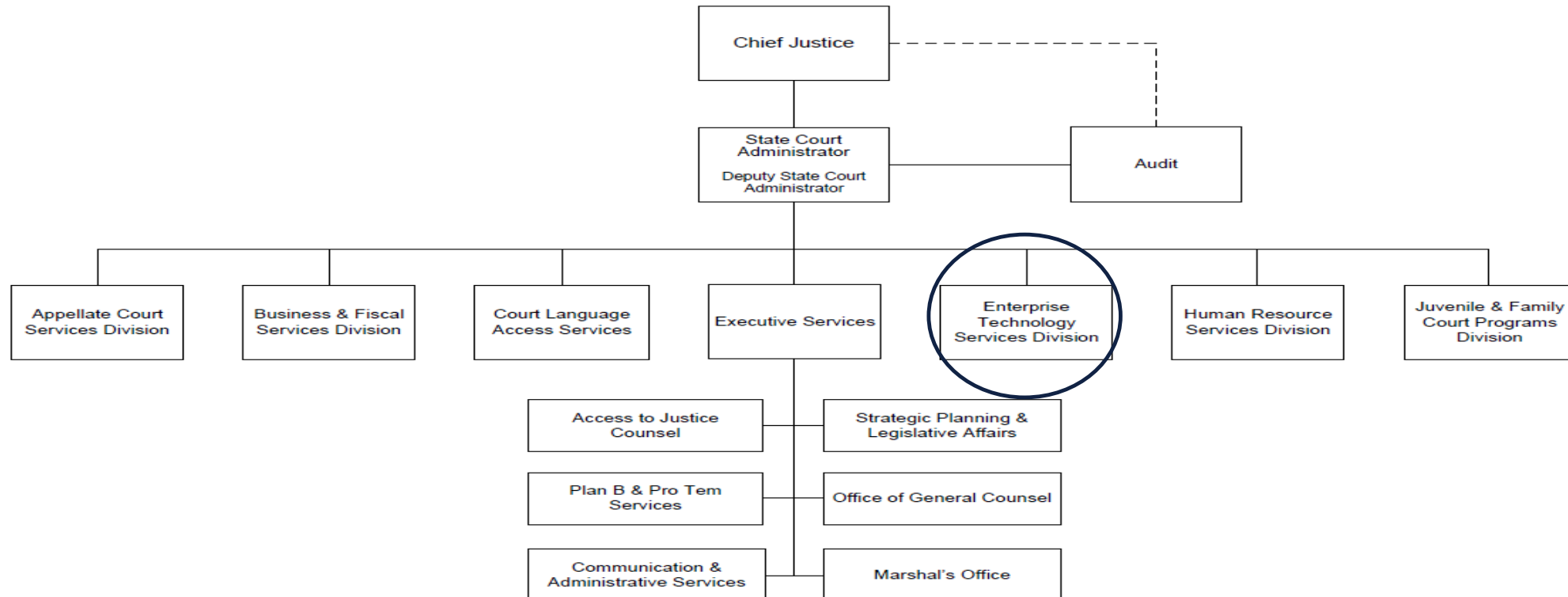


OREGON JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT STRUCTURE

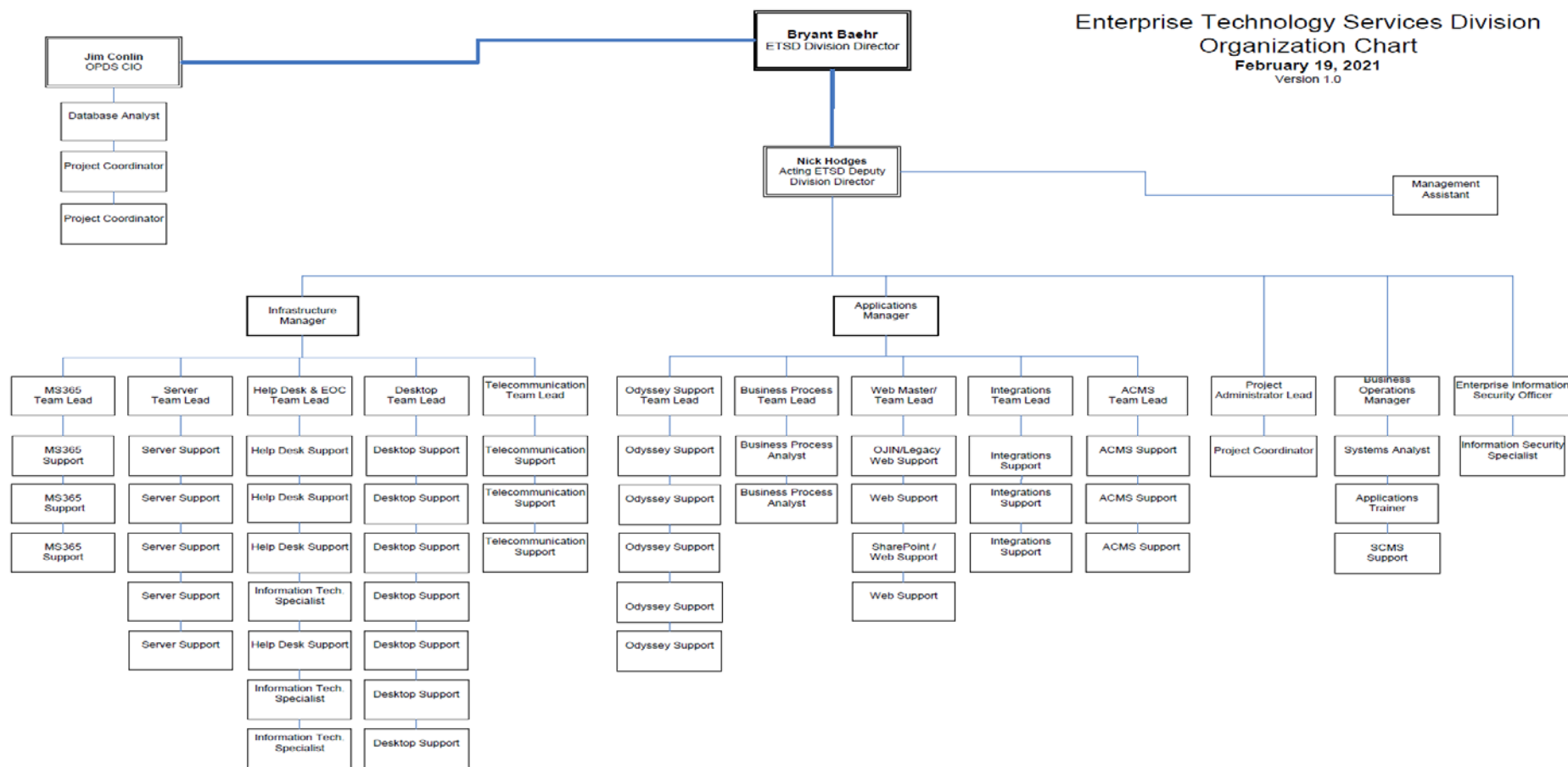

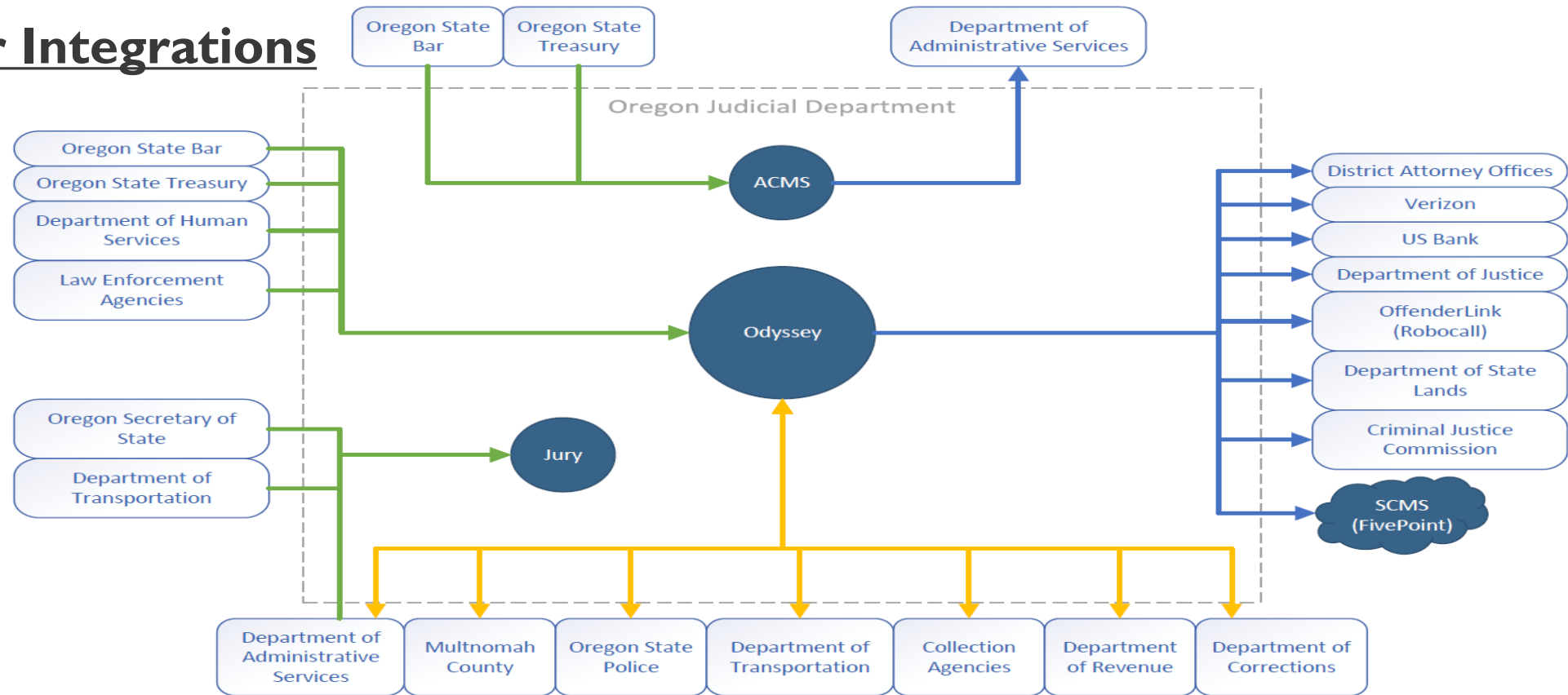

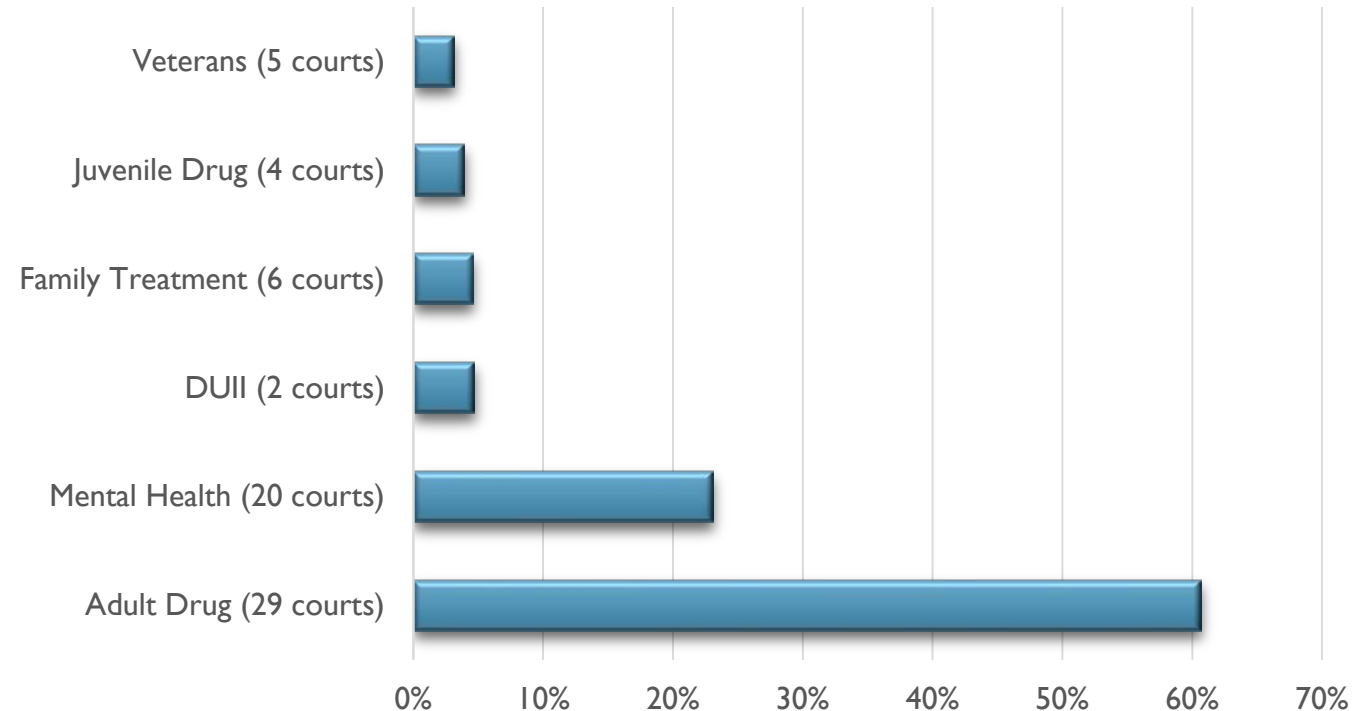


SPECIALTY COURT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (SCMS)

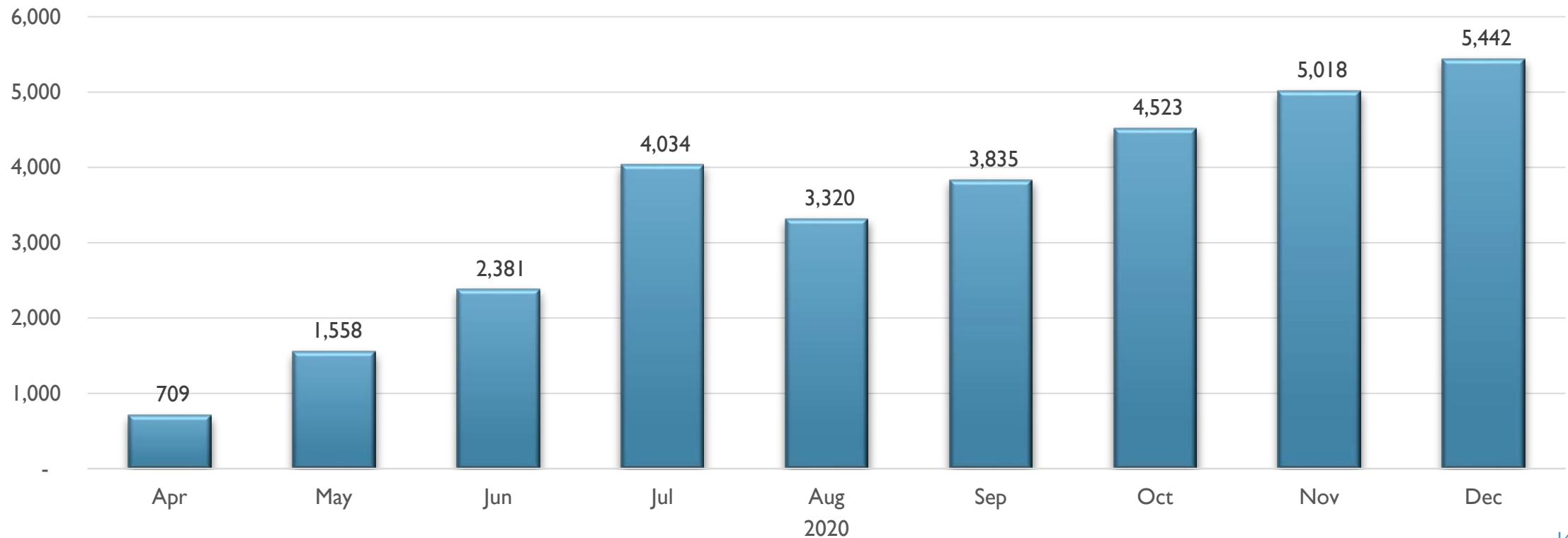

OJD iForms are currently available for the following case types:

- **Family Cases** - divorce, children, separation, parenting plan. File or respond to a case. Create a parenting plan that you can use on your own, or that you can file with the court as part of a family case.
- **Small Claims** - file a small claim or respond to a small claim
- **Residential FED-Eviction** - file a residential eviction
- **Satisfaction of Money Award** - court documentation of debt paid
- **Restraining Order** - Apply for, modify, dismiss, challenge or renew a FAPA Restraining Order

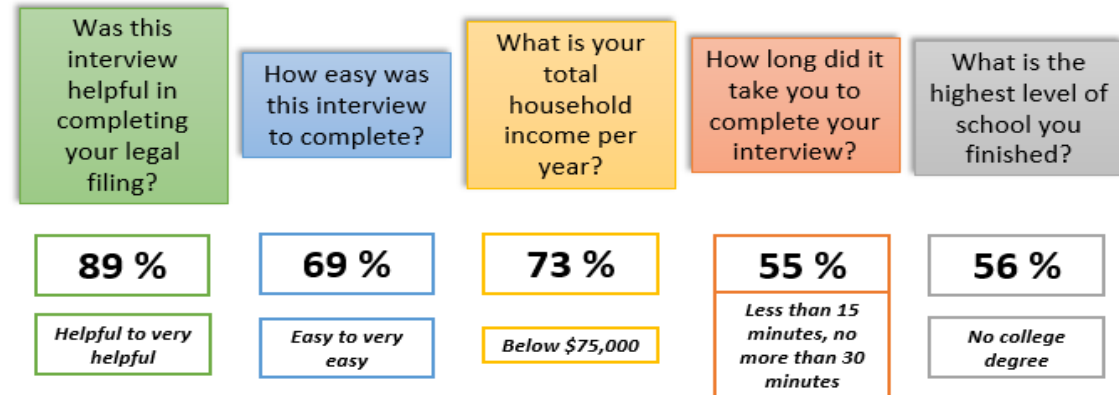
