ODOT Authority – Transportation system/facilities

ORS 279A.050 (3)

Procure or supervise the procurement of all goods, services, public improvements and personal services that relate to:

- Operating, maintaining or constructing highways, bridges and other transportation facilities
- Construct, acquire, plan, design and operate passenger terminal facilities and motor vehicle parking facilities
- Establish standards and conduct prequalification of prospective bidders on public improvement contracts


