## 2021-23 Governor's Budget Overview

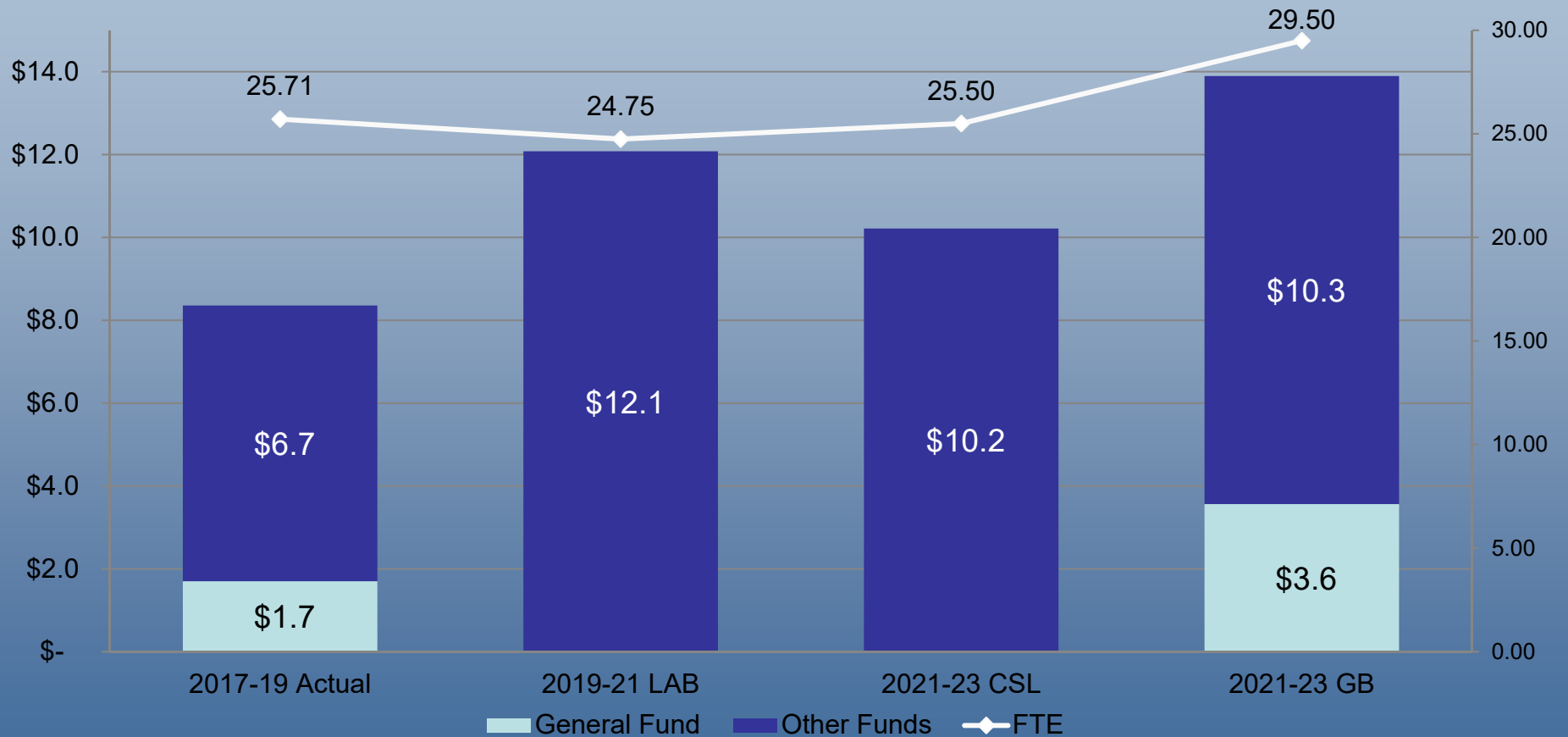
- Emerging Issues
  - Low ending balance due to insufficient fees
  - National Board Certification Program underutilization
  - COVID-19 possible impacts on Teachers Standards and Practices Commission (TSPC) licensure renewals
- Governor's Budget includes:
  - Fee increases to ensure sufficient ending balance for licensing and enforcement work,
  - Agency infrastructure investments, and
  - New program to expand pathways to licensure to increase the number of educators who are Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC).

## Expenditure History + 2021-23 Governor's Budget

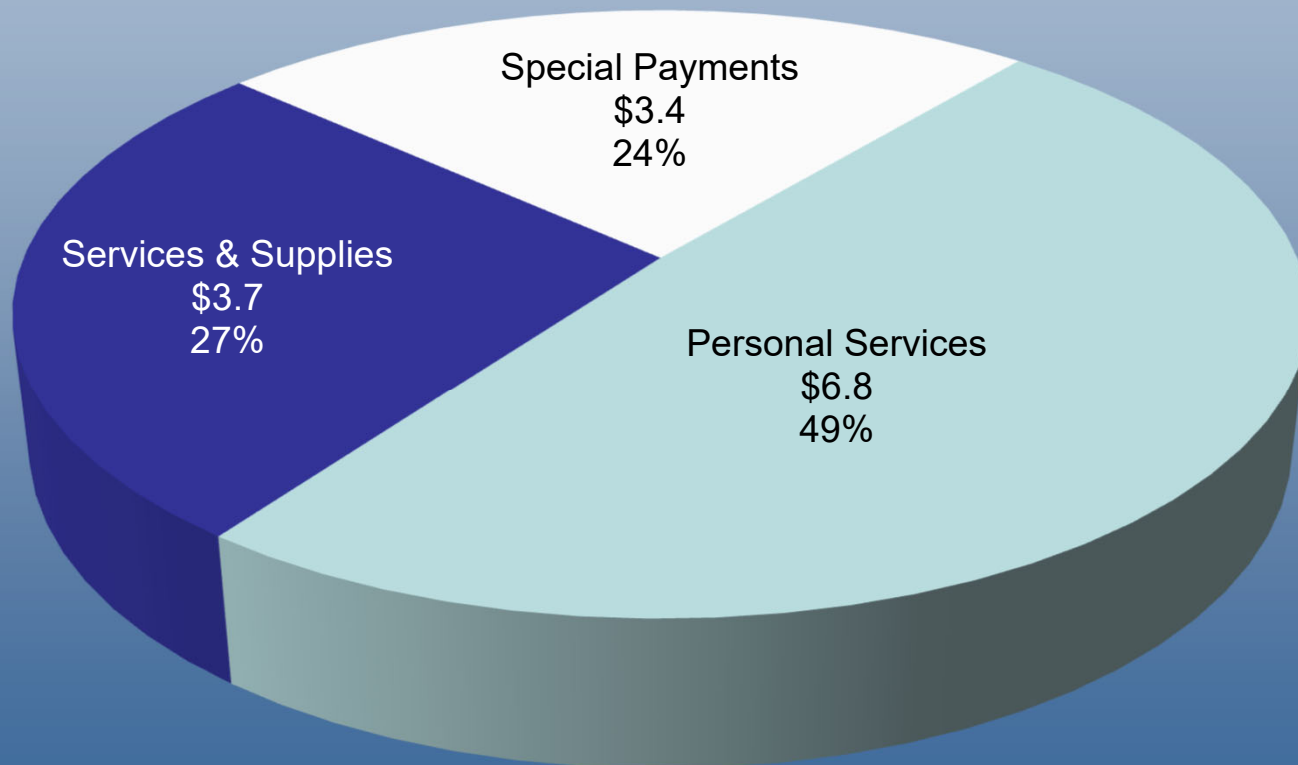

(in millions)**

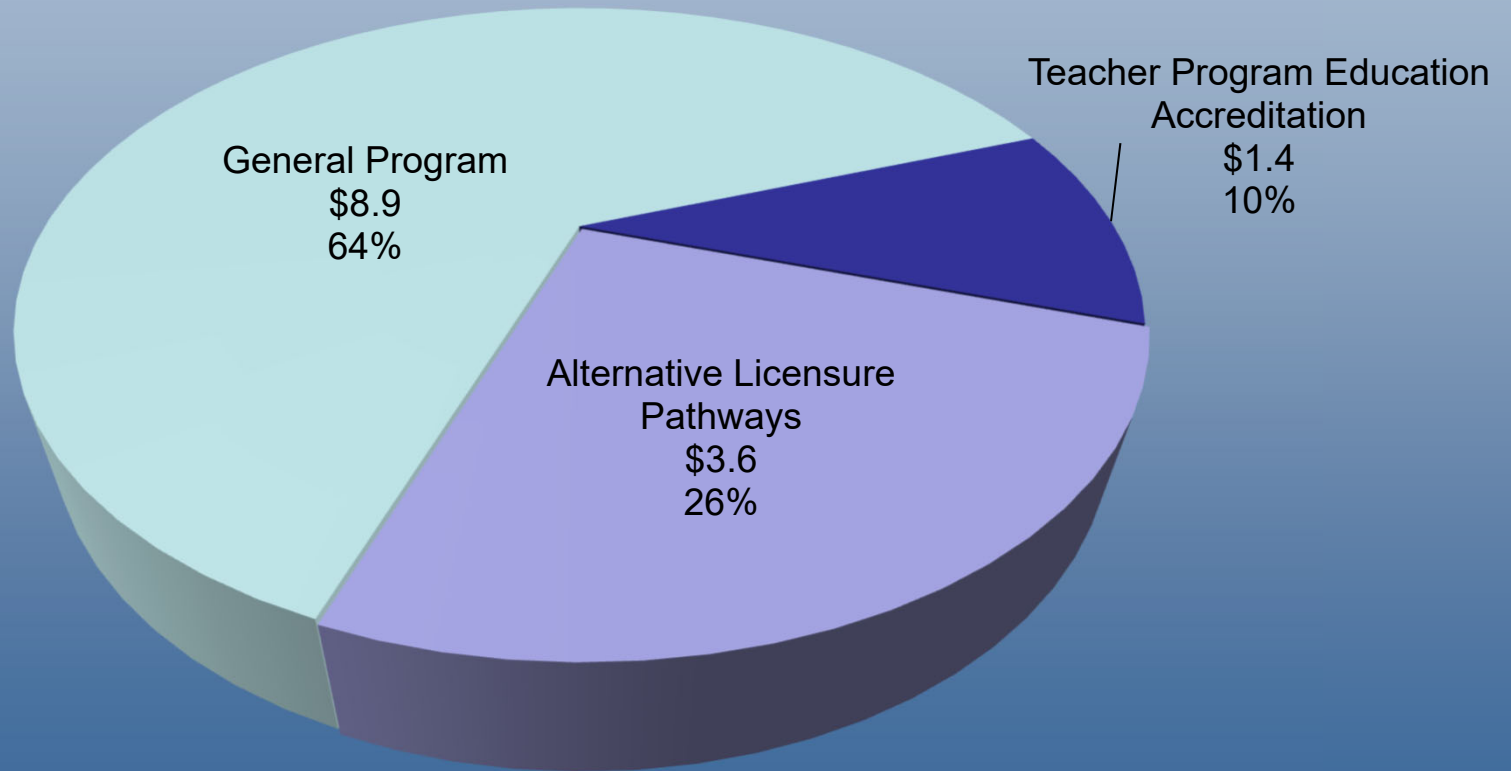

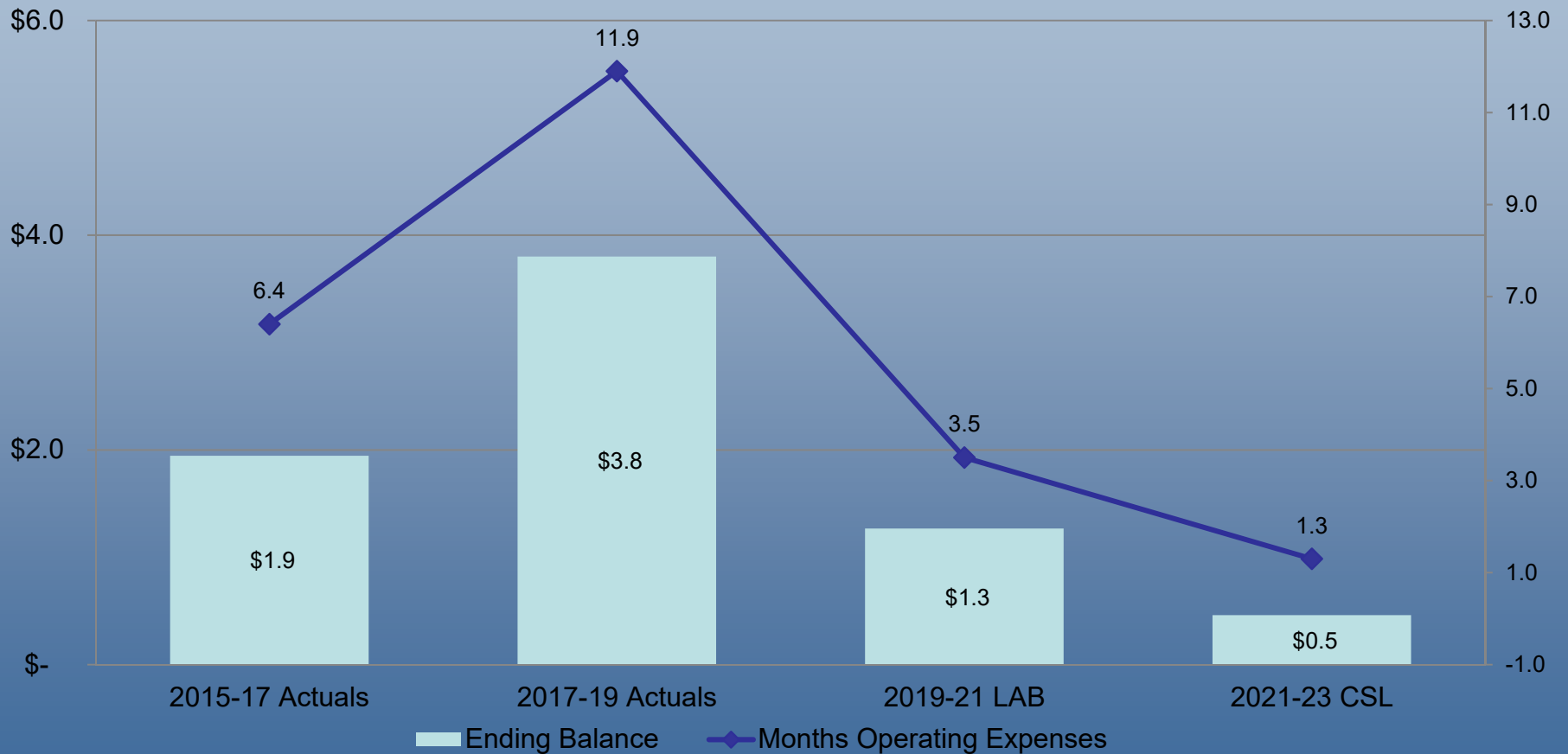

# Teacher Standards and Practices Commission

## 2021-23 Governor's Budget/Revisions

- **Governor's Budget**

- Increases license fees to ensure sufficient ending balances for operational expenses through 2027-29, from \$187 every five years to \$234 every five years (raises \$1.6 million);
- Establishes new Education Preparation Provider fees and provides authority to the Commission to levy fines and recover court and legal costs from contested cases – raises \$0.7 million (Senate Bill 129);
- Develops an eLicensing Application system and establishes fees to cover portal maintenance, payment processing (\$0.5 million);
- Creates a new program as recommended by the Governor's Racial Justice Council for Alternative Pathways to Licensure to expand opportunities for individuals to become licensed teachers (\$3.4 million);
- Provides resources to require Educator Preparation Programs to include specific training to support diverse students (\$0.2 million).
