WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires original equipment manufacturer of consumer electronic equipment to make available on fair and reasonable terms any part, tool, embedded software, and documentation made available to authorized repair provider. Provides private right of action to person who suffers loss of money or property as a result of original equipment manufacturer's failure to comply with provisions of the Act. Allows person to recover the actual damages or statutory damages of \$1,000, whichever is greater, along with attorney fees and court costs. Allows class action. Defines terminology. Applies to originated equipment sold or in use on or after the effective date. Takes effect 91st day following adjournment sine die.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

When certain home electronics are not functioning properly, the consumer may face the choice of replacing the product or paying for the repair services of a business authorized by the original manufacturer to make the repair. Attempting to repair the product at home or through a service not authorized by the original manufacturer may void the warranty, and the tools and instructions necessary to make the repair may not be available.

House Bill 2698 requires the original manufacturer of consumer electronic equipment to make parts, tools, embedded software, and documentation available to consumers and independent repair shops on fair and reasonable terms when these same items are available to authorized repair shops.
