My name is Greg Barbre, my wife Deborah and I lived at 1262 Rock Creek Road in Idleyld Park until our home and everything we owned was lost in the Archie Creek Fire September 8. Many others with similar stories have contributed far more detailed experiences and testimony yet I want to add our experience.

The recovery has been difficult and at times just too much...just too much. I knew it would be the most difficult time of my life and all I ask is that the organizations and governmental entities that are chartered to provide support do their utmost to help us. Some have and some have not. Many charitable organizations have been exceedingly generous. The Douglas County Assessors Office deserves no respect as they are indifferent to our needs. The organizations responsible for coordinating the ODOT cleanup have a byzantine process for signing up. I signed up, completed the survey and signed the ROE. I then get a call weeks later asking why I have not signed up for Phase 2. So I sign up again. I then go to the Glide Revitalization and find out my request is not processed, so I sign again.....still not updated on the computer.

All we ask is that you do what you can, and we will do the rest.
