

## **Current Wildfire Disaster Update**

- Individual Assistance and Public Assistance for 8 Counties
- Public Assistance Only for 12 Counties
- Programs in Process:
  - Public Assistance reimbursements, temporary and permanent repairs
  - Community Disaster and Small Business Administration Loan Assistance
  - Individuals and Households Assistance & Direct Housing
  - Disaster Case Management, Legal Services and Crisis Counseling
- Estimated Costs: \$1.1 Billion (not including housing mission)
- Current Public Assistance Obligations: \$159 million
- Individual Assistance Registrations/Approved: 24,301/3,090
- Current Individual Assistance Funds Disbursed: \$35.9 Million





### **Eligible Applicants:**

- Divisions of government
- School districts
- Some Private Non-Profits
- > 75/25 Cost share
- > Funding for:
- Debris removal
- Emergency Protective Measures
- Repair/replace damage to public infrastructure
  - Roads and bridges
  - Water control facilities
  - Buildings and equipment
  - Utilities
  - Parks & recreation






# Areas of Assistance: Individual Assistance (IA)

## **Eligibility in Oregon**

### How does Oregon compare?

- Current 15% eligibility rate
- 35% when suspected fraudulent registrations are removed
- In line with national average for federally declared disasters.

### Factors

- Fraud
- Duplication of benefits

### Application process

- Registration/documentation
- Small Business
- Denials & appeals
