


Harney Basin Estimates 2015



Irrigation rights vs. capacity

In some of Oregon basins, irrigators are allowed to use a greater percentage of the groundwater that winter rain and snow are estimated to replenish, according to an Oregonian/OregonLive analysis.

153 Ground Water Permits Issued in 2017

- 121 (79%) had a OWRD groundwater review that stated it "cannot be determined" whether ground water is over appropriated.
- 29 (19%) stated groundwater was not over appropriated
- 2 stated that groundwater was over appropriated
- 1 left the question blank
- The OWRD needs the information to make a informed decision.

Cause and effect

Lack of information

= over allocation + regulatory approaches = litigation

Knowledge

= Basin water budgets + cooperative regional approaches = reduced litigation
