WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Authorizes the Governor to enter agreement with another state to transport marijuana items from this state to the other state by a licensed marijuana producer, wholesaler, or retailer. Requires the agreement include a system to regulate and track the interstate transport of marijuana items.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

ORS 475B.010 to 475B.545 provide regulations for the recreational use of marijuana in the state. ORS 475B.227 prohibits the import or export of marijuana items, including industrial hemp products.

House Bill 3252 authorizes the Governor to enter into an agreement with another state to transport marijuana items from this state to the other state by a licensed marijuana producer, wholesaler, or retailer. The measure requires that the agreement include a system to regulate and track the interstate transport of marijuana items.
