Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Statutory Requirements³

The board consists of 24 members appointed by the Governor and subject to confirmation by the Senate.⁴ Membership must include:

- six administrators in common or union high school districts, one of whom may be retired prior to appointment (HIU; KLEWITZ; PELLICCI; PERRY; RICHARDSON; VACANT);
- six contract teachers, one of whom may be retired prior to appointment (POPE;
 SCONCE; VACANT; VACANT; VACANT; VACANT);
- six members of common or union high school district boards at the time of their appointment (AL-ABRADBBUH; HARTSOCK; MCVAY; PLACIDO; WESTRICK; WETZEL); and
- six members may not have any affiliation with any common or union high school district (BENNETT; JOHNSON; **GALLINAT**; MOYER; **PURVINE**; VACANT).

At least one member from each category must be a resident of a school district so that each type of school district described below is represented:

- a school district with an average daily membership of less than 1,500 students (JOHNSON; KLEWITZ; PLACIDO; POPE; PURVINE; WETZEL);
- a school district with an average daily membership of 1,500 to 4,500 students (PELLICCI; PERRY; RICHARDSON; WESTRICK); and
- a school district with an average daily membership of greater than 4,500 students (AL-ABRADBBUH; GALLINAT; HARTSOCK; HIU; MOYER; MCVAY; SCONCE).

Members serve four-year terms at the pleasure of the Governor and are eligible for reappointment. A member whose term has expired may continue to serve for the following limited purposes:

- to conduct a hearing and prepare a written decision if the member was appointed to a panel before the expiration of the member's term; or
- to reconsider a decision if the member served on the panel originally hearing an appeal and a motion for reconsideration is filed prior to an appeal to the Court of Appeals.

The board shall select one of its members as chairperson and another as vice chairperson, for such terms and with duties and powers necessary for the performance of the functions of such offices as the board determines. A majority of the members of the board constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business.

Duties and Authority

The board hears appeals of teacher and administrator dismissals and nonextensions of contracts and provides a uniform statewide system of pre- and post-determination due process for teachers and administrators.⁵ When a teacher or administrator files a timely appeal, the Superintendent of Public Instruction must appoint a panel of three members from the board for the purpose of conducting a hearing.⁶ Insofar as practicable, the panel must be selected from members representing the average daily membership that most nearly coincides with that of the involved district. The panel must consist of three members:

- one member from the category representing district school board members;
- one member from the category not affiliated with common or union high school districts;
- if the appellant is a teacher, one member from the category representing teachers;
- if the appellant is an administrator, one member from the category representing administrators.

The panel may not contain a member who is a resident of the district that is bringing the dismissal or nonextension. The Department of Education must provide appropriate professional and other special assistance reasonably required to conduct a hearing, and the Attorney General must assign an assistant to advise the board. The board may adopt rules necessary for the administration of its statutory duties.⁷

The board must:8

- receive and adjudicate appeals from administrators and teachers for dismissal, nonextension of a contract, or reduction in pay during the term of a contract;
- conduct a contested case hearing staffed by board members as appointed by the Superintendent of Public Instruction within 100 days of the receipt by the appellant of the notice of dismissal or statement of reasons for nonextension; and
- not later than 140 days after the filing of an appeal and after completion of the contested case hearing, prepare and send a written decision to the appellant, district superintendent, district school board, and the Superintendent of Public Instruction.
