

The mission of the Office of State Fire Marshal is to protect people, their property, and the environment from fire and hazardous materials.

International WUI Code and Defensible Space

- The IWUIC is a model code that is intended to be adopted and used supplemental to the adopted building and fire codes of a jurisdiction.
- Defensible Space is a component of the IWUIC
- Establishes minimum requirements to increase the survivability of life and property from wildfire.
- Code provisions are developed through science, data, and proven results from actual wildfire incidents.





What is the Wildland-Urban Interface (WUI)?

- The area where structures and other human developments meet or intermix with vegetative fuels.
- Communities adjacent to and surrounded by WUI are at varying levels of risk.






What is Defensible Space?


 A space around structures to prevent direct flame contact or radiant heat from wildfires.

- Slows the rate and intensity of an advancing wildfire.
- Increases the protection and fire suppression ability of the firefighters and structures.



Defensible Space Standards


 Minimum space requirements wherein combustible vegetation and trees are managed and kept away from buildings.





Defensible Space Includes Fire Resistant Vegetation

- High fire resistive fuels and high moisture content plants.
- Trees if they do not provide a means of transmitting fire to structures.
- Fire-resistant can help resist the spread of fire.


Wildfire Community Preparedness

- Preparing for wildfire incidents occurs before fire season begins.
- Community wildfire risk evaluation and planning efforts can increase resiliency.
- Defensible space around structures one element to improve chances of both life and property surviving a wildfire.




Implementing Defensible Space
