Dear Co-Chairpersons,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide information related to the Oregon Department of Corrections (DOC). Below is the response to information requested during the presentation to the Ways and Means Public Safety Subcommittee.

1. Please provide a list of the conditions listed on the graph on the final slide in reference to supervision disparity.

All individuals under supervision receive the same general conditions (GC) of supervision in Oregon. Special conditions (SC) are imposed on certain individuals based on their specific crime or specific behavior or need.

- GC05: Remain in the state of Oregon until written permission to leave is granted by DOC or a county community corrections agency. Offender automatically waives extradition if offender absconds and leaves the state.
- GC10: Obey all laws municipal, county, state, and federal.
- GC12: Do not possess weapons, firearms, or dangerous animals.
- GC15: Participate in a mental health evaluation as directed by the supervising officer and follow the recommendation of the evaluator.
- SC3: Without prior written approval of the Parole Officer (PO), do not contact a person under 18 years of age.
- SC4: Without prior written approval of PO, do not be present more than one time at, or on property adjacent to, a place primarily intended for the use by persons under 18 years of age or places where they regularly congregate.
- SC6: Enter, complete, or successfully discharge from recognized or approved sex offender treatment at direction of PO (may include Polygraph or Plethysmograph). Abide by conditions of sex offender treatment, do not possess sexually deviant materials, activities, or behavior unless allowed by PO.
- SC9: Offender shall not possess or use intoxicating beverages.
